

Notepad++ OFP Styles v1.1

Highlighting OFP scripting syntax

1. Overview

Files from the archive will enable custom code formatting in the Notepad++ program making script writing more convenient. It's meant for use with Operation Flashpoint scripts (SQS) and functions (SQF). Syntax highlighting will resemble C language code highlighting.

2. Installation

- Open Notepad++. Select „Language --> Define your language...”
- Click on „Import” and pick XML file from the downloaded archive
- Restart program
- Open an SQS/SQF file.
If you already had one opened then select „Language --> SQS/SQF C-Like”
